### **Family of Christ Lutheran Church** June 13, 2017 Minutes

Present: Pastor John, John Marsh, Tami Frye, Peggy Nelson, David Wiebe, Jane David, Connie Fie

**Devotion:** Pastor John gave the devotion from Psalm 100 noting worship results in action of the participants.

Minutes: President Marsh asked for a motion to approve the May 9 minutes. Minutes were approved.

Treasurer's report: Gross profit on May 17 was \$15,456.00 with total expense of \$11,330.78 and a net income of \$4,132.61. Operating checking is \$77,007.15 with \$16,321.30 restricted funds. John M asked for a motion to approve the treasurer's report (David/Jane). Approved.

Church Secretary Vacancy: Pastor John noted Council needs to approve Mutual Ministry team filling the church secretary position. The old job description was given to the Council for review. PJ noted the position had evolved into a 'print secretary'. It was noted a conversation with Barb Laursen and Joni Weed would clarify duties of the position. PJ made the motion to have Mutual Ministry team clarify the job description for 'print secretary' and put advertisement out for names to interview with Council approval. Motion carried.

Pastor John noted there are two items to be presented at the Congregational Meeting:

Creation of special financial team: As a follow-up to the Capital Campaign and a more accurate assessment of the congregation's willingness to investing in building, Hope Team has asked Council to create a team to develop a method for assessment. Names were suggested. PJ made the motion that suggested individuals be invited to be a part of the team to pursue stewardship strategies. Motion carried. David suggested personal contact be made with congregation members who were not part of the original contributors.

Diaconal position. Congregation will need to approve deacon ministry funding. A candidate is being sought and deacon ministry budget needs to be in place when the need arises.

Youth Group trip: Youth will be traveling to Sky Ranch in Colorado July 16. PJ asked Council for additional funding to help with transportation. Peggy noted there are funds of \$3500 from the sale of the car last Spring. PJ noted the cost per child is \$450. He asked if there might be some financial aid available to help families with this cost. David suggested covering \$250 per child drawing from unrestricted checking funds in addition to transportation expenses. President Marsh asked for a motion to approve (Peggy/Tami). Motion carried.

Motion was made (Jane/David) to adjourn.

Meeting was closed with the Lord's Prayer.

Registration is not limited to members of ELCA congregations, so we encourage you to share this information with any of your friends who might be interested in participating!


Registrations are now being accepted for the class beginning this September and going through April, 2018.

## The Funny Side of Discipleship

Jesus has a sense of humor!

Remember that story he told about a man trying to pick a speck out of a friend's eye while he has an enormous plank in his own? It's a funny 'glance' at hypocrisy.

Or the woman attempting to place yeast into enough flour for several hundred pounds of bread? A little can accomplish a lot!

His farmer (Mark 4) scatters seed wildly about, unreserved in sending it onto hard roads, into thorns, or onto rocks. Just like our gracious Father!

And then – Jesus takes that cluster of disciples to a mountain and sends them into the world. That same gaggle of Galilean former fishermen and tax collectors, who "worship and doubt" at the same time (Matthew 28), who stare at the sky wondering "what's next?" (Acts 1)...Jesus *sends them out* to continue his work. Actually, it's funnier in John 20 where Jesus (according to the Greek words) "flings" or 'hurls' them into the world to start doing 'spirit' stuff.

Jesus does have a sense of humor that he would entrust this work to ... people like us. Jesus does realize his disciples limitations and strengths. *And Jesus also knows the wonderful power of God to work in ministry through those disciples*.

Don't presume that the 'church', newly formed by that Pentecost Spirit, would be perfect and problem free! Reading through the book of Acts brings the realization that the Spirit was **most** present during 'uncomfortable opportunities': places where forgiveness could be breathed, where walls of prejudice and separation could be toppled, and where newly formed apostles could learn how God's grace would provide even in difficult situations.

One group of scholars teach that the Gospel of Matthew is a 'training' manual for disciples. I like that – and, since we are in the Gospel of Matthew for this summer (and through 2017), we view it as we continue to grow, sensing God's nurture behind our gracious words and actions, wherever they may be sent.

We may realize Jesus does have a sense of humor. But he's not laughing at us. It's actually a glee at seeing the surprising and delightful ways we...
